Letter from the Headmistress (I)

School would like to gain your attention on your child's safety in non-school hours and areas. One of our P.1 parents reported that a stranger grabbed her daughter's hand without notice when they were crossing the road in Wan Chai on 14th December 2016. In response to this incident, school made announcement immediately to remind all pupils to stay vigilant and suggestions were given to pupils on protecting themselves outside school.

Parents are requested to brief your child on the situation and arrange a care taker to escort your child on the way to school or home. You can refer to the suggestions for your child listed below:

1. Go home straight after school
2. Don't walk alone. Walk with your schoolmates, brothers or sisters when you are outside school
3. ***For children who go home with brothers or sisters, the elder ones should take good care of the younger siblings by holding their hands***
4. Stay with your care taker all the time outside school
5. Pay attention to any strangers around you
6. Shout loudly for help if any strangers try to grab you
7. Get help from adults or the Police around in the street when necessary
8. Report to the police if necessary

As the parents concerned reported the case to the police. Police also advice all of our parents to summon their assistance immediately through 999 if you find any suspicious persons. Police will continue to maintain presence in the vicinity of schools to ensure pupils' safety.

Since Christmas and New Year holiday is coming, school will have Christmas party for our pupils on 21st December, 2016. All pupils can come to school in casual wear and the dismissal time will be 12:20 p.m. on that day. Then, we will start our holiday from 22nd December, 2016 (Thursday) to 2nd January, 2017 (Monday). Parents are reminded to reserve time for your child to do revision and holiday homework. All pupils have to come to school again on 3rd January, 2017 (Tuesday).
