Notes on Picnic for Pupils

A. Before the picnic

3. Wear P.E. uniform
4. Bring sufficient food and drinks
5. Bring some tissue paper, a handkerchief, a moist towel and enough clothing
6. Take breakfast before leaving home, avoid over-eating
7. Label all the coats and belongings (lunch boxes, water bottles, etc.)
8. ***Bring mosquito repellent, suntan lotion and umbrellas if necessary***
9. ***Do not bring along valuable articles, knives, can-openers or glass-made bottles.***

B. Before setting out

1. Reach school on time
2. Queue up quietly for roll call and get on the coach in an orderly manner

C. During the journey

1. Do not leave your seat while the coach is in motion.
2. Do not eat or drink on the coach.
3. Avoid travel-sickness, you should refrain from eating too much in the morning, taking sweet things
4. Do not reading books or play electronic games on the coach.

D. On reaching the destination

1. Listen carefully to the teacher's instructions and do accordingly
2. Take good care of your belongings
3. Keep away from bushes or slopes
4. Keep away from animals such as dogs, cats and birds
5. Put rubbish into the litter-bins
6. Do not disperse until the teacher has made the roll call.
7. Do not leave your group without the teacher's permission.
8. Do not pick flowers or fruit.
9. Do not play with fire or have a barbecue there.
10. Do not buy or play with water guns.
11. Do not hire or bike in the park.

E. On leaving the destination

1. Be aware of the announcement or whistle-call for assembly
2. Queue up quietly for roll-call
3. ***Check all your belongings before you leave***
4. Ensure the place where you stay is clean

F. After the picnic

1. There will be no post-lesson activities after the picnic.
2. ***Go home straight away after dismissal***
3. ***Do not linger about in the streets.***
